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### **Information regarding Medical Examination**

Dear Crew Member,

An **ITALIAN PRE-BOARDING MEDICAL EXAMINATION** (incl. Foodhandler -for personnel designated by the company-) is necessary prior to each embarkation. **Upon the day of embarkation the examination may not be older than 10 days if it was done outside Italy.**

For Italian crewmembers being resident of Italy or examinations done in Italy the deadline is 3 days prior embarkation. This examination can be done only by approved Italian doctors as per the list published from Italian Health Ministry.

In addition every crew member needs a **NATIONAL MEDICAL EXAMINATION** for seafarer, which is valid for 2 years and can be done at any time prior embarkation, but needs to be valid for a minimum of the intended contract duration plus 6 months. This examination should include a testing of the eyesight. If eyesight testing is not part of the NATIONAL MEDICAL EXAMINATION, a separate eye sight examination including issuance of separate certification needs to be undergone. The eyesight certificate is valid for 6 years.

The NATIONAL MEDICAL EXAMINATION as well as the eyesight certificate can be issued only by the doctors appointed by national maritime authorities and is based on national regulations and therefore differs from country to country.

The original national medical certificate (and if issued separately the eyesight certificate, too) and the original Italian pre medical certificate are to be carried on board for embarkation, a copy is to be send to the Human Resources Management in advance

The costs for the Italian pre medical examination will be reimbursed upon submission of the original receipt.

The expenses for the first national medical examination of new hired crew members have to be paid by the crewmember and are not subject to reimbursement.

The expenses for the national medical examination of re-hired crew members are subject to reimbursement upon submission of the original receipt.
